

The BHS foreign language department, known best for their relaxed enforcement of school rules, has announced a new stance against perpetrators. BHS EATING CONTRACT

After seeing the astounding success of the BHS Dance contract this past January, Mr. Sills has decided to use the same method to regulate the manner in which students eat their lunches.

The teachers who chaperone the lunches are tired of watching the disgusting ways students consume their food, so they have imposed a series of strict regulations to clean up the cafeteria. They have complained that it is not the way that they ate when they were in high school, so it can't be tolerated.

The administration has also received numerous complaints from students who are hesitant to attend the school lunches because of the gross eating habits they are forced to witness.

"If the students want to eat that way, they'll have to do it somewhere else." Said BHS principal John Sills. We do not tolerate these inappropriate habits in our cafeteria, and we feel it is our right to control the way students eat." Sills also added that if students continue to break the rules, he will cancel all future lunches for the rest of the year, and he said, "Lunches are a privilege, not a right, if you abuse that privilege it will be taken away."

Rule 1: Students entering lunch will be subject to random searches, and a student caught trying to sneak their own food into the cafeteria will have the food confiscated and will be sent home.

The foreign language department is not stopping there, however. A new set of punishments has been installed with the hopes of really giving rule-breaking students what they deserve. Students caught using or possessing a phone, iPad, or other electronic device will immediately be sent to Osvaldo Mejia's room to have that device destroyed. If any student is caught copying another student's assignment, both students will receive an automatic failing grade for the year. The foreign language computer lab is being converted into a small jail containing twelve cells. All second offenders will be placed in the jail for no less than three days. MATT COUGHLIN'S KNEE ANNOUNCES RETIREMENT

After 18 rough years, Matt Coughlin's right knee has announced that it is permanently retired from physical activity. On Tuesday March 13th the knee suffered its fourth ligament tear during a pick up basketball game and recently underwent its third surgery in the past two years. "I just can't take it anymore," the knee said during its retirement speech, "I have been letting Matt down for years and it is finally time to give up the charade."

Many speculated that this announcement would happen in October after Coughlin's knee tore its MCL in a football game, and he was ruled out for the season. Matt's knee added, "After Matt's football career was over, I didn't want him to be done playing sports, so I convinced him I would be stable enough to play some pick up basketball, but I have disappointed him again."

After the first three tears, it seemed that the knee's injuries were happening in increasingly important situations. The first occurred when he was lifting weights, the second during an intense football practice, and the third finally occurred during a Friday night football game. Because of this pattern the knee was optimistic that it could only be torn during a very important athletic event, and not in something so trivial as a pick up basketball game.

Last May, Coughlin's knee led him and his team to the finals in the dodgeball tournament without any sign of injury, and this gave him hope that it had made a full recovery. "He was diving and jumping with extreme quickness," said Matt's knee, "and I wasn't holding him back at all. I thought I was back to normal. I had no idea I would tear two more times in the next year. I thought I was better than that."

Coughlin's knee is worried about its public image, and wants people to remember who it used to be, before all the surgeries.

"I have been operated on so many times," said the knee, "that I can't even recognize myself in the mirror anymore. I look like a completely different knee. I just want to go back to the way I used to be, when Matt could run and jump and compete athletically." Upon reminiscing about the past, Coughlin's knee began to cry, adding that it feels like an utter disappointment.

Coughlin's knee also added that if it were to try to come back after this injury and tore another ligament then it could be replaced by a younger mechanical knee, and it would rather retire on its own terms than be replaced by a machine.





And now, the dudes are lining up cause they hear we got swagger


But we kick em to the curb unless they look like Mick Jagger ---> Any reason? Again with the poor judgement.

Po-po shut us down ---> Every party has a pooper...


